



### DSHS Covered Diagnosis Codes

Here is the list of diagnoses codes that represent conditions DSHS considers medically necessary under the new foot care policy. It is numerical and I have linked it in excel form so you can resort by alphabet. It does not list every possible covered diagnosis. Other acute non-listed conditions may be covered and you should obtain prior authorization.

Remember, even though a code may be covered, machines process claims and since it is not listed, you should obtain prior authorization. Here is the best resource on prior authorization
